**ORDER**

[1] Heard Mr. K. Roshan, learned counsel for the petitioner.

[2] The petitioner is aggrieved by the transfer order dated 22.12.2025 transferring him from GC-Imphal to 216 Battalion CRPF, Odisha and also rejection of his representation by order dated 10.02.2026, whereby, his transfer to 216 Battalion CRPF, Odisha is confirmed. It is stated that the respondents have not considered the acute medical conditions of the wife of petitioner as stated in standing order- 04/2022 dated 27.09.2022.

[3] The learned counsel for the petitioner prays for stay of the impugned transfer order dated 22.12.2025 and rejection of the representations by order dated 10.02.2026 during the pendency of the present petition.

[4] Issue notice.

[5] Mr. S. Vijayanand Sharma, learned Sr. PCCG accepts notice on behalf of respondent nos. 1 to 5. Hence, service is complete on the respondents.

[6] The learned Sr. PCCG for the respondents has pointed out that the medical conditions of the wife of petitioner is not covered under 'para no. 7(i)' of the standing order- 04/2022 dated 22.09.2022 and psychiatric problem of the petitioner wife is not included in the medical ground for retention. It is

also stated that the petitioner has been posted at Imphal for a period of 10(ten) years and consecutive 3(three) years in the last posting. It is submitted that no interim order is called for at this moment.

[7] List this case on 15.07.2026.

[8] However, it is made clear that the pendency of the present writ petition does not bar the respondents for considering the representation of the petitioner on compassionate ground.
