Heard Mr. K. Eengba, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

Issue notice, returnable within 2 weeks.

Mr. Shyam Sharma, learned GA entered appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 2 & 3, hence, no formal notice is called for in respect of the said respondents.

Petitioner is to take steps for service of notice upon respondent No. 1 by way of dasti service.

Steps should be taken within 2 working days and the petitioner is to file an affidavit showing proof of service of such notice.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that in view of the nature of the dispute raised in this writ petition and the relief sought for therein, there is element of an amicable settlement of the dispute through mediation proceedings.

The learned counsel accordingly prays for referring these matters for mediation.

In view of the submission made above, Registry is directed to refer these matters to the Mediation Centre, High Court of Manipur for exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement.

The petitioner and the respondent No. 1 or any officer duly authorized by it in writing and who can settle the dispute are to be present before the appointed Mediator on 19.06.2026.
