Heard Mr. Y. Nirmolchand, learned senior counsel assisted by Mr. Y. Nikheel, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

Issue notice, returnable within four weeks.

Mr. H. Samarjit, learned senior counsel and GA assisted by Mrs. R.K. Emily, learned Deputy GA entered appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 4, hence no formal notice is called for in respect of the said respondents.

Petitioner is to take steps for service of notice upon respondent No. 5 by way of speed post service.

Steps should be taken within one week and the petitioner is to file an affidavit showing proof of service of such notice.

The learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an old aged person and the respondent

No. 5 is the son of the petitioner. It is the case of the petitioner that on 07-06-2026 at about 06:00 PM, the respondent No. 5 forcibly throw out the petitioner and his old aged wife, who is the mother of the respondent No. 5, from their house and locked the main entrance door of the house of the petitioner and the main gate of the said house. The grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner and his wife are old aged persons and as they have been thrown out by their son forcibly from their house, they have nowhere to reside. The learned counsel, accordingly, prays for passing an interim order directing the respondent No. 3, viz., the Superintendent of Police, Imphal West, to ensure that the petitioner and his wife are allowed to reside in their house and to ensure their safety from their own son, who is the respondent No. 5 herein.

Taking into consideration the peculiar circumstances as raised in this writ petition, this court is of the considered view that an interim order is called for. Accordingly, the respondent No. 3, viz., the Superintendent of Police, Imphal West, is hereby directed to ensure that the petitioner and his wife are allowed to enter and reside at their own home and to ensure their safety from the respondent No. 5, who is their own son and other persons.

Registry is directed to furnish a copy of this order to both the counsel appearing for the parties through their WhatsApp/e-mail during the course of the day for doing the needful.

List these cases again on 03-09-2026.
