[1] Mr. Y. Nirmolchan, learned senior counsel assisted by Mr. Y. Nikhil, learned counsel for petitioner, on instruction, submits that writ petition may be permitted to be withdrawn as the cause of the writ petition does not survive.

[2] It is submitted that by the present writ petition, the petitioner challenged his transfer order dated 23.06.2026 whereby he has been transferred from the post of Executive Engineer, Highways South Division as SW to Superintending Engineer-I, PWD, Manipur. Vide order dated 25.06.2026, this Court stayed the operation of impugned transfer order dated 23.06.2026 confining the transfer of petitioner as impugned transfer order was in violation of transfer policy of the State.

[3] When the matter is taken up today, Mr. Y. Nirmolchan, learned senior counsel for petitioner, submits that transfer order dated 23.06.2026 concerning transfer of petitioner has been cancelled by subsequent compliance order dated 30.06.2026 and in the circumstances, the cause of the writ petition does not survive and petitioner is going to retire on 31.08.2026 on attaining the age of superannuation.

[4] Mr. S. Niranjana, learned G.A. for State respondent, submits that he has no instruction. However, the oral prayer of learned senior counsel for petitioner may be acceded to.

[5] Recording the submissions made at the bar by learned senior counsel for petitioner, writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn as the cause of the writ petition does not survive. Misc. application is accordingly disposed of. Interim order is merged with the final order.
