Mr. H.S. Paonam, learned Senior Advocate assisted by Mr. Chinglemba, learned counsel appeared on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. D. Julius Riamei, learned counsel appeared on behalf of the respondents.

The present writ petition has been filed with a prayer to issue a direction to the respondents for refunding an amount of Rs. 7,41,195/- (rupees seven lakh forty-one thousand one hundred and ninety-five) from the bills of the petitioner, which has been deducted as a liquidity damage.

Both the learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the learned counsel appearing for the respondents submitted that the said deducted amount has been refunded back to the petitioner and as such, the present writ petition can be closed as infructuous since the petitioner has got the relief sought for in this writ petition.

In view of the submission made by both the counsel appearing for the parties, the present writ petition as well as the connected application are hereby closed as infructuous.
