Heard Mr. Serto T. Kom, learned counsel appearing for the applicant.

Issue notice, returnable within three weeks.

Mr. Niranjana Sanasam, learned GA entered appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 and hence, no formal notice is called for in respect of the said respondent.

Applicant is to take steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 2 by way of dasti service. Steps should be taken within one week and the applicant is directed to file an affidavit showing the proof of service of such notice.

I have heard the submission made by the learned counsel appearing for the applicant and also carefully examined the materials available on record. The learned GA appearing for the respondent No. 1 seeks three weeks' time for filing a detailed objection. As prayed for by the learned GA, list this case again on 09-11-2023.

In the meantime, as an interim measure, it is hereby directed that if the applicant is arrested in connection with the FIR No. 4(09)2023 CB-PS U/S 7(b)/13 PC Act & 120-B/34 IPC before the returnable date, she shall be released on bail on her furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) with one surety (a government employee) of the said amount. It is also made clear that the applicant should co-operate with the Investigating Authority in connection with the said FIR and she should not temper with any evidence or influence any witness. It is also made clear that applicant should not go outside the State of Manipur without prior permission of the Arresting Authority. If the applicant violates any of the conditions mentioned herein above, the respondents are at liberty to approach this Court for cancellation or modification of this interim order.

List these cases again on 09-11-2023.
