Learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. KR Pamei is on record, however, he is represented by learned counsel, Mr. I. Somorjit.

Learned Advocate General, Mr. Lenin Hijam for the State is on record, however, learned senior counsel Mr. M. Rarry states that the matters have been entrusted to him from the office of Advocate General and he is now representing the State of Manipur in these matters.

This submission which is made by the learned senior counsel is taken on record.

The present writ petition has been filed for seeking intervention of the issues in between the petitioner and the respondents in respect of the impugned Act, i.e., Kaina Temple Board Act 2023 as declare

the same as ultra vires. Therefore, learned counsel for the petitioner be directed to apprise the scope of Article 14, 15, 26 and 31A of the Constitution of India.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner in these matters seeks some short accommodation on the premises that he wants to go through the entire material available on record inclusive of the aforesaid Kaina Temple Board Act, 2023.

Keeping in view the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, it is deemed appropriate that these matters would be listed on 30.07.2025.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to file synoptic notes in terms of the aforesaid Articles 14, 15, 26 and 31A of the Constitution of India.

Registry is directed to delete the name of learned Advocate General from the cause list and print the name of Mr. M. Rarry in the cause list as learned senior counsel for the State.
