[1] Heard Ms. Ayangleima, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. S. Niranjana, learned G.A. for the State respondent.

[2] When the matter was taken up on 03.10.2025, Mr. N. Jotendro, learned senior counsel, submits that he is filing Caveat on behalf of respondent No. 3 on the same day. However, as per the Registry noting, no Caveat has been filed and the petitioner has already furnished copy of the petition to the learned senior counsel.

[3] Since respondent No. 3 does not appear on Caveat, the matter is heard and considered on the available record.

[4] Issue notice.

[5] Mr. S. Niranjana, learned G.A., accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 & 2.

[6] Petitioner is directed to take step to respondent No. 3 by speed post and dasti in addition and file affidavit of proof of service.

[7] Ms. Ayangleima, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the petitioner was earlier declared non-responsive in the technical bid. However, on clarification, the bid of the petitioner was declared as technically responsive.

[8] The respondent No. 3 who is one of the qualified bidders lodged a complaint against the petitioner about non-disclosure of the pending litigation against the petitioner and on the basis of the complaint lodged by respondent No. 3, the petitioner's bid was cancelled without giving any show cause notice to the petitioner declared as technically non-responsive and respondent no. 3 is the only qualified bidder.

[9] Later on, the petitioner submits that respondent No. 3 itself concealed three pending litigations against it in its bid.

[10] It is prayed that the minutes of the Technical Evaluation Committee dated 25.09.2025 and declaring respondent No. 3 as technically qualified be set aside.

[11] During the pendency of the present petition, status quo directed on 03.10.2025 shall be maintained till the next date.

[12] List this case on 14.11.2025.
