Mr. Rendy Maibam, learned counsel appeared for the petitioner and Mrs. L. Monomala, learned GA appeared for the respondents.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that the petitioner was placed under suspension by an order dated **05-07-2010** issued by the Director of University and Higher Education, Government of Manipur as a result of the arrest of the petitioner and police custody in connection with FIR No. **114(5)2010 PRT PS u/s 376/325/34/120-B**. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the Criminal Trial in connection with the said FIR was disposed of by a judgment dated **28-06-2022** passed by the Fast Track Special Court No. 2, Manipur at Lamphelpat in Sessions **Trail Case No. 10 of 2015/27/2020**. By the said judgment, all the accused including the petitioner were acquitted from the charges framed against them and

they were set at liberty. It has also been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that no Departmental Enquiry has been initiated against the petitioner by the authorities till date. It has also been submitted that taking into consideration the fact that the criminal case against the petitioner in connection with the above mentioned FIR has already been closed by exonerating the petitioner from all the charges and as no Departmental Enquiry is pending against him, the impugned order dated **05-07-2010**, placing the petitioner under suspension, deserves to be quashed and set aside.

Mrs. L. Monomala, learned GA appearing for the respondents submitted that she is yet to receive instruction from the authorities, accordingly, the learned GA seeks one week's time as a last chance for obtaining instruction from the authorities.

As prayed for by the learned GA, list these cases again on 15-09-2026, on which date an endeavour shall be made to dispose of the writ petition.
