[1] Heard Mr. M. Hemchandra, learned sr. counsel assisted by Mr. M. Rendy, learned counsel for the petitioner.

[2] The petitioner is an association of shop owners and they approach this Court for implementation of the order dated 03.06.2022 passed by this Court in W.P. (C) No. 529 of 2016 whereby, 6(six) shops no. 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 & 10 at Ngari Dukan Temporary Market Complex at Khwairamband Bazar, Imphal to be divided into 2(two) shares and allotted the same to the petitioner (who are the petitioner herein) and private respondent nos. 5-13 (who are not the parties in the present writ petition).

[3] It is stated that IMC who are respondent no. 3, herein is to make proper allocations in terms of the earlier order. It is the specific case of the petitioner that the petitioner is not able to get proper share in terms of the earlier order and this shall be a dispute arising herein.

[4] Issue notice.

[5] Mr. S. Niranjana, learned GA accepts notice on behalf of respondent nos. 1, 2, 4, 5, 6 & 7 and Ms. Neha, learned counsel assisting Mr. Y.

Nirmolchand, learned sr. counsel accept notice on behalf of respondent no. 3 (IMC). Hence, service is complete on the respondents.

[6] Mr. Y. Nirmolchand, learned sr. counsel for the IMC raises the question of maintainability of the present writ petition as non-joinder of necessary party who are the occupants of the remaining shares.

[7] The learned counsels for the respondent pray for 3(three) week's time for filing counter affidavit.
