The applicant has filed the application under Section 378 (4) of the Cr.P.C. being aggrieved by the order of acquittal dated 23.07.2012 passed by the Fast track Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Bhopal (Shri Manoj Kumar Tiwari) in R.T. No. 6916/06, whereby respondent No.2 is acquitted of the offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Since none has been appearing on behalf of the applicant on hearing dates, this Court has given a prior warning by observing in the order-sheet dated 17.02.2016 as that if none appears on behalf of the applicant on the next date of hearing to prosecute the application, the Court may consider its dismissal for want of prosecution. Despite this, today none has appeared on behalf of the applicant even in the second round after the recess. As a corollary, this application is dismissed for want of prosecution.

Accordingly, this application stands disposed of.
