- 14.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Mr. H.K. Mahanta, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks for some time in the matter, but Mr. S. Sekhar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Mr. D. Routray, learned counsel for O.P. No.5 submits that the present Writ Petition is not maintainable in its present form as the petitioner had to approach the Education Tribunal, but he has not approached the said Tribunal.
3. On the other hand, Mr. D. Mohapatra, learned ASC appearing for O.P. Nos. 1 to 3 submits that the present petitioner is also not maintainable for want of proper party impleaded in the Writ.
