01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as learned counsel for the State. Perused the writ application as well as the documents annexed thereto.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at the outset contended that the Petitioner had earlier approached this Court by filing W.P.(C) No.16696 of 2025 which was disposed of by a Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 24.06.2025 thereby granting liberty to the Petitioner to approach the Opposite Party No.2 by filing a representation and the Opposite Party No.2 was directed to consider the same within a stipulated period of time. After disposal of the abovenoted writ application although the Petitioner has approached the Opposite Party No.2, and no final decision has been taken as of now by the said Opposite Party No.2, in the meantime



the governing body of the college has started deducting from the salary of the Petitioner as is evident from the letter dated 01.12.2025 at Annexure-7. Being aggrieved by such conduct of governing body of the institution, the Petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present writ application.

4. On the request of learned counsel for the State, he is granted four weeks' time to obtain instruction in the matter.

5. List this matter in the week commencing 23.02.2026.

6. In the meantime, notice be issued to the Opposite Party No.4 by Speed Post with A.D fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within three working days.

7. Learned counsel for the State accepts notice on behalf of the Opposite Party Nos.1 to 3.

8. Heard.

9. Notice as above.

10. Accept one set of process fee.

11. As an interim measure, it is directed that no recovery from the Petitioner pursuant to the letter under Annexures-7 and 9 shall be made till the next date.
