1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is an application by the petitioner seeking permission for stating his name and address in the cause title of the bail application and the name of the petitioner in the order.
3. Heard. It appears that the accused-petitioner has allegedly described him to be the husband of the victim of POCSO offence. Law is fairly well settled that the name of the victim should be concealed not only with reference to her own name, but also with reference to her address etc. and, therefore, the petitioner has concealed his name by stating as "Accused Husband". It is, however, submitted that the learned Court in seisin over the matter is not honoring the order which has been passed by this Court for want of the name and address of the accused-petitioner.
4. In the aforesaid situation, the Court in seisin over the matter is requested to verify the name and



address of the accused from the record, instead of asking the accused-petitioner to produce a modified order containing his name and address, which in the circumstance appears to be not inconsonance with law.

5. Accordingly, the learned Court in seisin over the matter is requested to carry out the order by verifying the name and address of the petitioner and if the learned Court in seisin over the matter comes to a conclusion that the petitioner is not the husband of the victim, he may pass appropriate order, but if the accused is the husband of the victim, the learned Court in seisin over the matter should give effect to the order of this Court.

6. Hence, the I.A. stands disposed of. A copy of this order be immediately transmitted to the concerned Court for compliance.
