1. By the impugned judgment dated 19.07.2004 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Titilagarh, Bolangir in Sessions Case No. 12(B)/18 of 2002 arising out of G.R. Case No. 213/2001 corresponding to Sindhekela P.S. Case No. 30/2001 convicted the appellants under Section 302/149 IPC and sentenced them to Rigorous Imprisonment for life.
2. Pursuant to the order dated 03.03.2010 passed earlier in this appeal, the appellants are on bail. It is seen that the learned counsel for the appellants did not appear in the matter when it was taken up on 25.11.2025, 19.02.2026 and 24.02.2026.
3. As per our order dated 19.02.2026, though the Registry informed Mr. H. K. Mishra, learned counsel for the appellants, but he did not appear in the matter even today when it was called.



4. Registry shall inform the appellants through the IIC of Sindhekela Police Station, Bolangir about the next date of hearing of this appeal.
5. Failure on the part of the appellants to remain present before the Court on the next date fixed, either by themselves or by learned counsel/advocate representing them, the Court shall consider to pass consequential order.
6. List this matter again on 23.04.2026.
7. Registry shall communicate this order forthwith to the IIC, Sindhekela Police Station as well as the Superintendent of Police, Bolangir.
8. Registry shall also serve a copy of this order to Mr. P. S. Nayak, learned AGA, for his necessary use.
