1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).

2. Mr. S.S. Pradhan, learned AGA is present. Mr. Santosh Kumar Dwivedy, learned counsel for Respondent No.3 informs the Court that he has got no instruction to proceed with the matter.

3. In the aforesaid situation, since Respondent No.4-Bala @ Baladev Bankra has since been expired, the appeal against Respondent No.4 has been ordered to be abated, but Respondent Nos. 2 & 3 has already been informed and therefore, Mr. S.S. Pradhan, learned AGA is requested to inform the Respondent Nos.1 & 5 about the pendency of appeal before this Court. Further, the learned convicting Court has not yet submitted the Part File record.



Hence, Registry is requested remind the convicting Court to submit the Part File record by next date.

4. Mr. S.S. Pradhan, learned AGA is requested to apprise this Court about the status of execution of the conditional warrants issued against the respondents to be produced before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rourkela, who shall release the Respondents on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) only with one solvent surety as ordered by this Court on 30.01.1996 while admitting the bail.

Further, seen the report of the DR (Judicial), wherein he has already taken steps by calling for explanation from the erring officials and this Court being satisfied with such explanation submitted by the Superintendent, Criminal Appeal Section and the Dealing Assistant advises them to remain careful in future for avoiding same lapses.

6. A free copy of this order redacting the observation of this Court made in paragraph-5 be supplied to the learned AGA for compliance in the matter.
