1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
  2. Learned counsel for the State, on instruction, submitted that the Victim has married the principal accused in the meantime and they are staying together at the Petitioner's place as husband and wife. She further contended that as per the instruction received from the concerned IIC, the Victim has given undertaking, and as per the instruction, they both are living happily in the locality as husband and wife. Further, in course of the inquiry the Informant filed an amicable settlement letter before the IIC, Laxmipur P.S.
  3. In view of the aforesaid development, this Court directs that the statement of the Victim be recorded under Section 164 of Cr.P.C. by the learned Magistrate and a copy of such statement be forwarded to this Court by the next date.



4. Further, it is open to the learned counsels appearing for the Petitioner as well as the Informant to file a joint affidavit after serving a copy thereof on learned counsel for the State.
5. Learned counsel for the State shall also obtain instruction with regard to the genuineness of such affidavit by the next date.
