- 03.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the Parties.
3. Pursuant to the order dtd.30.01.2026 and 25.02.2026, learned counsel appearing for the TPNODL contended that Petitioner challenging a proceeding initiated against him is before this Court in W.P.(C) No.12514 of 2024 and this Court while issuing notice of the matter vide order dtd.20.05.2024 has passed an interim order in restraining the Opposite Parties from proceeding with the disciplinary proceeding.



4. But in the present Writ Petition, nothing has been disclosed about the pendency of the aforesaid Writ Petition and no certificate has been given in that regard. (Copy of the order dtd.20.05.2024 so produced by Mr. L.K. Moharana, learned counsel appearing for TPNODL be kept in record).

5. This Court after going through the petition also finds that no certificate has been given regarding pendency of W.P.(C) No.12514 of 2024 and the same amounts to suppression of material fact. This Court accordingly directs learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner to file an affidavit as to why Petitioner did not disclose about the pendency of the aforesaid Writ Petition and nothing was also indicated in the certificate so furnished.

6. As requested by the learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner, list this matter on 22nd April, 2026. Affidavit be filed before the next date positively.
