The Office objection, being insignificant, is overruled.

The prayer of the Auction Buyer of the security property
reads as under:

*“It is, therefore, prayed that this Hon'ble Court may
graciously be pleased to direct the Opp. Parties Lie
Housing Finance Ltd. to complete the auction sale forthwith
in favour of the petitioner and further be pleased to direct
the learned DRT, Cuttack to dispose of S.A. No. 161/2024
within a stipulated period without any further adjournment
in the interest of justice;*

*And pass any other order/orders,
direction/directions as may be deemed fit and proper;”*

2. Learned counsel appearing for Petitioner submits that if a
direction is issued to the DRT, Cuttack to hear and dispose off
pending S.A. No.161 of 2024 within a reasonable time, keeping



open all contentions of the parties, justice would be met to all the stakeholders. We agree.

In the above circumstances, Writ Petition is disposed off accordingly, requesting the DRT to accomplish the task within an outer limit of three (3) months. All contentions are kept open.

Notice to other side is dispensed with, since we are passing innocuous order.

Now, no costs.
