1. By the order dated 02.02.2026, as it was found that on 09.09.2025 learned SDJM, Bhadrak in ICC Case No. 65 of 2020 had issued notice to the IIC, as order for execution of the NBW along with DW had not been complied with, the matter had been adjourned to today by this Court to enable the learned Additional Standing Counsel to obtain instructions from the IIC, Bhadrak (R) Police Station as to why the NBW and DW have not been executed till date and that if instructions are not received by 09.02.2026, the IIC will be required to file an affidavit by 11.02.2026.

2. Today when the matter is listed, Mr. A. K. Apat, learned Additional Government Advocate submits that the IIC, Bhadrak (R) Police Station has submitted that despite several efforts and trying their level best, it was not possible to execute the warrant and DW in respect of Basanta Das till date and prayer has been made for grant of 15 days' time to execute the warrant.



3. Apart from mentioning that several efforts were made and utmost level best was tried to execute the warrant, details of the steps taken for execution of warrant have not been stated.

4. List this matter on 24.02.2026.

5. Considering that the matter is adjourned to 24.02.2026, in the meanwhile, if the DW and NBW are not executed, the IIC, Bhadrak (R) Police Station shall file an affidavit giving details of the steps taken since 04.05.2023 for execution of the DW and NBW issued against the Opposite Party No.2, failing which the IIC will be required to remain present in the Court in person or through virtual mode on 24.02.2026 to assist the Court in disposal of the CRLMP.
