1. A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 20th March, 2025 had said as under:

“I.A. No.94 of 2025 & MATA No.75 of 2025

1. Heard Mr. B.P. Mohanty, learned counsel for the Appellant and Mr. A.K. Patra, learned counsel for the Respondent.

2. Mr. Patra is served with a copy of the I.A. and he wants to file his objection.

3. List the matter on 6th May, 2025.

I.A. No.116 of 2025

4. In the meantime the husband – Respondent is directed to pay interim maintenance of Rs.25,000/- (twenty five thousand) for maintenance of the minor son as admittedly he is serving as an Engineer at Pune with sufficient income.”



2. Subsequently time was granted to the husband on the ground that he had preferred a challenge to the said order before the Apex Court of the country. Till date no payment is made. Obviously this money ought to have been paid on account of the minor son. Added the husband happens to be an Engineer at Pune having sufficient income. This version appears in the order dated 20th March, 2025.

3. It is not denied before us that the husband is an Engineer with good income. If at all he has any deference, it is qua the wife and not the minor son. Law, religion and humanity injunct the person to pay maintenance to the minor sons. The law reports in this connection galore in libraries.

4. In the above circumstances, we direct the arrest and production of respondent-Dip Shankar Manna, before this Court on 2nd July, 2025. Registry to send a copy of this order to the Director General and Inspector General of Police in Maharashtra for implementation of the same.

5. However, if the said respondent remits the said amount of ₹25,000/-+ ₹5,000/- as additional sum to the Registry of this Court



within 10 days from today, his arrest shall not be effected. We make it clear that this payment is without prejudice to contentions of the parties.

6. Call this matter for compliance on 2nd July, 2025.
