**ORDER

01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. In fact, petitioner No.1 is the husband of the informant and both are doctors in their profession, whereas, petitioner No.2 happens to be the mother of petitioner No.1. In support of the education qualification of petitioner No.1, Mr. Sahoo, learned counsel appearing for him refers to Annexure-2 series. For a dispute in the family, petitioner No.2 is said to have lodged a report at Kozhikode in the State of Kerala. It is informed to the Court that the marriage between petitioner No.1 and informant had taken place in Kozhikode itself.
3. Recorded the submission of Mr. Mishra, learned counsel for the informant, according to whom, petitioner No.1 committed the mischief in sending his intimate photographs with the informant to her father through WhatsApp. It is



informed to the Court that petitioner No.1 is presently at Gwalior for further studies, whereas, petitioner No.2 is at Kozhikode and informant is staying at Cuttack. In view of the above and submissions of learned counsels for the respective parties, the Court is inclined to direct the State to cause production of the case diary and to take instruction as to if any such mischief has been committed by petitioner No.1 as has been alleged by the informant and described therein the report and to reply back.

4. List on 23rd March, 2026 for further orders and in the meantime, this Court, as an interim measure, directs that the petitioners shall not be taken into custody in connection with G.R Case No.1128 of 2025 corresponding to Mangalabagh P.S. Case No.408 of 2025 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C (CT) Court, Cuttack. The State is to collect the necessary information as has been directed besides causing production of the case diary and other police papers for the Court's perusal on the next date of hearing. At the same time, the Court is of the view that the parties should be directed to go for mediation, hence, requests both to attend the High Court Mediation Centre at Cuttack on 20th March, 2026 to receive further orders.
