1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is the bail application U/S.483 of the BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Nayakote PS Case No.04 of 2025 corresponding to ST Case No. 57 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Keonjhar for commission of offences punishable U/Ss. 103(1)/109(1) of IPC, on the main allegation of committing murder of the deceased Tarini Prasad Mohanta @ Bubu and injuring the informant Manoj Kumar Mohanta by dashing them by a Bolero vehicle while the deceased and injured were on a motor cycle.
3. Heard, Mr.Sandeep Raj Panda, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. T.K.Acharya, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record including the deposition of witnesses so far examined as supplied.

The impugned order reveals that the trial is at fag end and all most all the witnesses have already been examined, but on a perusal of materials placed on record and keeping in view the evidence of the witnesses examined so far, more particularly that of PW2, this Court hardly finds any good ground to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

5. Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stands rejected. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of. A copy of this order be immediately communicated to the learned trial Court.
