1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is a bail application U/S.483 of the BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Rengali PS Case No. 217 of 2023 corresponding to CT (Sessions) Case No.96 of 2024 pending in the Court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Jharsuguda for commission of offences punishable U/Ss. 452/395/397 of IPC r/w Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, on the main allegation of committing dacoity in the house of the informant by assaulting PW11.
3. Heard, Mr. Dharendra Kumar Mohapatra, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. S.C. Pradhan, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.
4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offences as alleged against the petitioner vis-à-vis the allegation sought to be brought against him and regard being had to the identification of the Petitioner



in TI parade keeping in view the evidence of PW11, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stand rejected. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of. A soft copy of the order be immediately sent to the learned trial Court.
