07. 1. On perusal of record, it appears that when the matter was listed on 16th February, 2004, this Court adjourned this matter with direction to the learned Additional Government Advocate to produce the original case records in RMC No.224 of 1990 from the Office of the Revenue Officer, Panposh. Thereafter, the matter was listed on 25th March, 2004 and got adjourned due to none appearance of the petitioner and, accordingly, the matter was listed on 15th March, 2004, on the request of the learned counsel for the petitioner, this matter was further adjourned. Today, none represented on behalf of the petitioner at the time of call.

Since this matter is of the year 2004 and none is present to pursue this matter even though on earlier occasion adjournment was granted on the prayer of the counsel appearing for the petitioner, it is construed that the petitioner has lost interest to pursue this matter.
