This CRLMP has been filed with the prayer to issue a writ of mandamus directing the Opposite Parties to register an FIR forthwith within a stipulated time on the basis of the Petitioner's complaint dated 06.09.2025, and Opposite Party Nos. 2 and 3 to personally supervise the investigation and ensure compliance with the law laid down in ***Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh, (2014) 2 SCC 1*** and call for or a status report from the Opposite Parties explaining the reasons for non-registration of FIR despite lapse of several months.

2. List this matter on 19.02.2026 to enable learned counsel for the Petitioner to produce decisions of the Apex Court where it has been decided that the High Court in exercise of power under Article 226 has to issue a writ of mandamus to the Police Authorities to register an F.I.R.
