01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. In filing this Writ Petition, the Petitioner claiming himself to be the rightful owner of the disputed property in question, has challenged the impugned notice dated 31.12.2025 vide Annexure5 and the order dated 26.12.2025 passed in U.C. Case No.29 of 2025 vide Annexure-6.
- Apart from the above, the Petitioner has also sought for a direction from this Court to the Opposite Parties for not demolishing the structure standing over the disputed property in question.
3. Heard.
4. Issue Notice.
5. Learned counsel for the State waives of notice on behalf of the Opposite Party No.1. Let an extra copy of the brief be served on her within three working days hence. She is



directed to file reply within two weeks from the date of receipt of the brief.

Learned counsel for the Petitioner is directed to serve an extra copy of the brief on Mr. Gyana Ranjan Mohapatra, learned counsel for the C.D.A and also an extra copy of the brief on Mr. Debashish Nayak, learned counsel for the C.M.C within a period of three working days hence. They are directed to file their respective replies within two weeks from the date of receipt of the brief.

7. List this matter on 28th January, 2026.
