02. 1. Mr. Ashok Kumar Apat, learned Additional Government Advocate produces the instructions dated 12.02.2026 of the I.I.C., Mancheswar Police Station, Bhubaneswar UPD submits that that the NBW issued against Hinduja Leyland Finance, Branch Manager, which has been fixed for execution on 10.12.2024 has been returned from the Police Station on 07.09.2025 with the prayer for issue of fresh warrant for execution as the execution date has expired.



2. Mr. Prakash Kumar Mishra, learned counsel submits that he has instructions to appear on behalf of the Legal Manager, Hinduja Leyland Finance, having office at Creative Plaza 3rd Floor, Rasulgarh Square, Bhubaneswar. He further submits that there is no post of Branch Manager in the said office of Hinduja Leyland Finance, therefore notice in the complaint case has not been served on any officer of Hinduja Leyland Finance Bhubaneswar Branch. He also submits that as there are various procedural irregularities and illegalities in the orders passed by the learned Magistrate, the certified copies of the relevant orders have been applied for, so that they can be challenged in appropriate proceedings. He prays for an adjournment to file an affidavit in this case.
