1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.

2. Heard Mr. Binaya Kumar Mohanty, learned counsel who is appearing from the Virtual High Court at Jagatsinghpur for the Appellant/Applicant. This is an application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act read with Chapter 6 Rule 27 of the Orissa High Court Rules for condoning the delay of 344 days as per the Stamp Reporter's report in filing the intra-Court appeal challenging the order dated 02.01.2020 passed by the learned Single Judge in W.P.(C) No.834 of 2002.

3. Issue notice as to why the aforementioned delay of 344 days shall not be condoned or any other order(s) shall not be passed as deemed appropriate in the circumstances. Notice is made returnable on 29th September, 2023. Since Mr. Tuna Sahu, learned counsel has appeared before us on instruction for the Respondents, no formal notice is called for.

4. Mr. Sahu, learned counsel shall file his Vakalatnama within three working days from today. Mr. Binaya Kumar Mohanty, learned counsel, on the other hand, is requested to supply two copies of the writ appeal to Mr. Sahu, learned counsel within three working days.

5. The Appellant shall take further steps for service of notice on Respondent No.4 by Registered Post with A.D. within three working days.

6. Let the matter be listed on 29th September, 2023.
