07.02.2018 Heard Mr. A.K. Biswal, learned counsel on behalf of Mr. K.K. Gaya, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. A.K. Nayak, learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.

The petitioner files this application to seeking for a direction to opposite parties to constitute a high power official committee to declare the actual legal heirs of late freedom fighter Saheed Rendo Majhi and the award given to opposite party no.5 shall be withdrawn and be handed over to him as he is the actual legal heir of Saheed Rendo Majhi.

Mr. A.K. Biswal, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the fact has already been brought to the notice of Union of India and in response to the same, on 04.07.2017, the Government of India has already directed the Chief Secretary to Government of Odisha to consider the representation of Shri Bikas Das, President of CLAP Legal Service Institute to constitute a high level committee to declare legal heirs of Late Freedom Fighter, Rendo Majhi, but till date no action has been taken.

Mr. A.K. Nayak, learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State prays for and is granted two weeks time to obtain instruction in the matter.
