1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the Parties.
3. Pursuant to order dtd.18.02.2026, learned counsel appearing for the TPCODL contended that seeking Police help for providing the electricity connection to the Petitioner's premises, Opp. Party No. 2 though moved the local Police vide letter dtd.11.03.2026 with a request to depute police personnel on 13.03.2026, but on the said date because of law and order situation, power supply could not be provided to the Petitioner's premises. Copy of the instruction so provided by Mr. L.K. Maharana, learned counsel be kept in record.
4. In view of the submission so made, this Court grants liberty to the Petitioner to move the appropriate forum to get the benefit.
5. With the aforesaid liberty, the writ petition stands disposed of.
