01. 1. Heard Mr. S.C. Mekap, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. G. Tripathy, learned AGA for State – opposite parties.
2. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that though the Tahasildar has passed order under Annexure-1 in Encroachment Case No.529 of 1993 to settle the land in favour of the father of the petitioners as an encroacher, but due to his death the authorities are not taking any steps on said order of the Tahasildar. It is further submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they may be permitted to submit a representation to the Tahasildar.
3. Accordingly the writ petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioners to submit a representation before the Tahasildar, Nimapada (O.P. No.4) ventilating their grievance. In the event the petitioners submit their representation before the Tahasildar within a period of two weeks from today along with certified copy of this order and copy of the writ petition, opposite party no.4 shall consider and



dispose of the same, in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks thereafter.

4. An urgent certified copy of this order shall be issued on proper application.
