1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant I.A. is filed seeking modification of the Court's order dated 28th January, 2026 in the ABLAPL.
3. This Court had directed release of the petitioner upon his surrender before the learned court below with other conditions besides absence of any such grievous injury received by the victim/informant, which according to Mr. Parida, learned counsel for the petitioner, has been received by the victim with a fracture injury and refers to a copy of the MLC Record as at Annexure-1 to the I.A. Recorded the objection of the State. Considering Annexure-1 to the I.A., the Court finds that the injury is a fracture to the right forearm, which is not on the vital part of the body and considering the same and since the petitioner has been allowed to go on bail after surrender, this Court is in favour of modifying the above condition and accordingly, it is directed thereby allowing the I.A. with a



direction to the petitioner to surrender before the Court concerned in compliance of the order in ABLAPL and upon such surrender fulfilling other conditions, he shall be released on bail as has been ordered. It is further directed that the petitioner shall surrender before the learned court below within the extended period of three weeks from today as the time stipulated earlier has expired in the meantime.

4. I.A. is disposed of as a result.
