1. Registry has pointed out that as per the stamp report dated 29.01.2026, a part of Annexure-5 is not available in the record.
2. Perusal of the record reveals that the petitioner had earlier filed RPFAM 422 of 2025. As there was certain defect in the RPFAM, the case had not been registered and D- RPFAM No. 50173 of 2025 had been initially assigned to it. The stamp reporter had indicated that the matter should be registered as CRLMP, and the nomenclature was not correct. The petitioner had filed I.A No. 631 of 2025. Thereafter, RPFAM No. 422 of 2025 was registered. By order dated 09.01.2026, I.A No. 631 of 2025, application for change of nomenclature from RPFAM to CRLMP had been allowed. Thereafter, the matter was registered as the CRLMP. Stamp report was again conducted and the stamp reporter on 29.01.2026 has reported that page No. 25 is not available. But, this was had not pointed out by the stamp reporter who had conducted the stamp report of D- RPFAM No. 50173 of 2025.
3. Mr. R. N. Panda, learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to file page No.2 of the order passed in Civil Proceeding No. 376 of



2024 (Annexure-5), by 12.03.2026 along with the corrected index. He also undertakes to serve a copy of the same on Mr. P. Panda, learned counsel for the Opposite Parties before the next date.

4. It is stated by Mr. P. Panda, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Opposite Party that the Opposite Party has not got anything towards maintenance and application under Section 125 of the Cr.P.C. is pending since 2024.

5. List this matter on 18.03.2026 on which date, an attempt will be made for final disposal of the CRLMP.

6. The page and index shall be placed in the petition and scanned and incorporated in the digital record.
