- 15.** 1. Heard learned counsel Mr. Nanda for the Petitioner and learned counsel Mr. Swain for Opposite Party No.1 and learned counsel Mr. Panigrahi for the State.
2. On instruction, it is submitted by the learned counsel Mr. Nanda, that in terms of the order dated 26.02.2026 amount of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs) has already been deposited.
3. Learned senior counsel for the Opposite Party Mr. Das does not oppose such submission.
4. In view of the above, it is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as the opposite Party No.1, that their clients are agreeable to explore the possibility of settlement of the matter through ADR by way of Mediation.



5. Accordingly, the matter is referred to the learned coordinator, District Mediation Centre, Berhampur, Ganjam to nominate a learned Mediator having not less than ten years of experience at the Bar to act as mediator. Registry is requested to do the needful.

6. To cut short the delay, the Petitioner as well as the Opposite Party No.1, shall appear before the learned Mediator on 11.04.2026 at 11.30 A.M to receive further instruction(s).

7. List this matter on 29.04.2026 along with the report of the learned Mediator.

8. In view of the above deposit of Rs.2,00,000/-, it is directed that no coercive action shall be taken against the Petitioner till the next date.
