- 13.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
2. This I.A. has been filed by the Petitioner seeking an extension of time to deposit a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs) in terms of the order dated 29.01.2019 passed in I.A. No.49 of 2019. The said order reads as under:

"xxx xxx xxx

There shall be stay on realization of fine imposed against the petitioner vide judgment dated 01.08.2018 passed by the learned S.D.J.M., Berhampur in I.C.C. Case No.155 of 2016 Trial



No.248 of 2018 pending finalization of the Criminal Revision No.32 of 2019, subject to deposit of Rs.2,00,000/- (rupees two lakh) by the petitioner before the learned trial court within 15 (fifteen) days from today.

xxx xxx xxx"

3. Though the order was passed seven years back, the same has not been complied with and on this day the Petitioner has submitted Demand Draft bearing No.152380 dated 23.02.2026 of the State Bank of India in the name of the Opposite Party No.1, namely, Baidya Ranjan Nanda. Copy of the Demand Draft is enclosed to the said memo. While submitting a Demand Draft the details of the Demand Draft have been indicated in the memo as stated above. The Demand Draft is taken on record.

4. Registry is requested to hand over the same to the learned counsel for the Opposite Party No.1.

5. Taking into account the patent non-compliance with the order of this Court dated 29.01.2019, the Petitioner is directed to make a further deposit of Rs.2,00,000/- within a period of two weeks hence before the learned Trial Court on or before 17.03.2026.

No coercive action shall be taken against the Petitioner till 17.03.2026.



6. In the event, the amount of Rs.2,00,000/- as directed is not deposited within the stipulated time, it shall open for the learned Court in seisin to take action in accordance with law.

7. In the event the said amount is deposited, the same shall, on being moved, be released in favour of the Opposite Party. The deposit of Demand Draft and further sum of Rs.2,00,000/- shall be without prejudice to rights and contention of the parties.

8. Accordingly, the I.A. stands disposed of.
