1. Mr. R.B. Dash, learned Additional Standing Counsel submits that the CRLMP is not maintainable as the Petitioner has not followed the procedure under Section 174 of the BNSS as copy of the complaint has not been sent to the S.P. after the IIC allegedly refused to register the FIR.
2. Perusal of Annexure-7 of the CRLMP reveals that FIR has been sent to the IIC, Bantala Police Station on 03.11.2025 by Speed Post.
3. Perusal of the fresh date-chart, filed by the learned counsel for the Petitioner, reveals that there is a mistake in the date-chart as it has been mentioned that the Petitioner has sent a copy to the S.P.,



Angul through Registered Post but there is no averment or any supporting document to indicate that the FIR has been sent to the S.P., Angul through Registered Post. That apart, Registered Post service is no longer available.

4. List this case on 27.02.2026 to enable Mr. R.B. Dash, learned Additional Standing Counsel to obtain instruction.
