08. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. This Misc. Case has been filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay of 10 days in presentation of the leave petition before this Court.
3. The above noted leave application has been filed at the instant of the State-Petitioner thereby seeking leave to challenge the judgment of acquittal dated 16.12.2009 passed by the Judge, Special Court, Angul in Special Case No.11 of 2006.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner, at the outset, contended that



notices have been duly served on all the Opposite Parties.

5. On perusal of the record, it appears that despite valid service of notice neither the Opposite Parties nor their counsel appeared before this Court while the matter was taken up on 10.10.2025 as well as 07.11.2025.
