02. 1. By means of this application, the Petitioner seeks for the following relief:-

“That the petitioner therefore prays that this Hon’ble court may graciously be pleased to admit this petition, Issue notice to opposite parties By considering the facts and grounds stated above a direction may issue to the opposite parties Tahasildar, Kujanga to correct the Final R.O.R, and prepared a new Khata in the name of the petitioner. Separately as per the Judgment and decree passed by the Civil Judge (senior Division) Kujanga in T.S.No.30/2002 and Final Decree case No.03/2021 (F.D.) dtd.10.3.2017 in Khata No,53 , Plot No.44. Mouza-Sahada , Khata No,427 Plot No.744 , Mouza- Chatua and Khata No.41 Plot No. 15 Chaka No. 11 Mouza-Parapada under the Kujanga Tahasild of Jagatsinghpur District in the name of the petitioner.”

2. Having heard the learned counsel for the Petitioner and perusal of the averments made in the application, it reveals that subsequent to the final decree, the Petitioner never moved before the learned Tahasildar for effecting the partition seeking correction of the R.O.R. However, the prayer made by the Petitioner is premature.



3. In the above circumstances, the learned counsel for the Petitioner seeks the permission of this Court for withdrawal of the application to move the learned Tahasildar with proper application for correction of R.O.R. pursuant to the decree passed by the competent court of law. The same is allowed. The writ application is dismissed as withdrawn with a liberty to the Petitioner to move the Tahasildar in accordance with law for correction of R.O.R. pursuant to the decree passed.
