1. Heard Mr. Mohapatra, learned Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioners through virtual mode.
2. Instant I.A. is filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act seeking condonation of delay.
3. A delay of 166 days is reported as per S.R.
4. The submission of Mr. Mohapatra, learned Sr. Advocate for the petitioners is that the delay is technical and, hence, to be condoned since the revision is filed against the order of cognizance as at Annexure-3.
5. Considering the plea of the petitioners and the submission as above and as the cognizance of order dated 17th April, 2025 i.e. Annexure-3 is under challenge, this Court, accepting the explanation offered towards delay, is inclined to condone the same in the interest of justice.
