1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.
2. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS by the petitioner seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Tangi P.S. Case No.312 of 2025 corresponding to G.R. Case No.264 of 2025 pending in the court of learned NGN-cum-J.M.F.C., Tangi on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. Recorded the submission of Mr. Chand, learned counsel for the petitioner. An offence under Section 64 BNSS is alleged besides other allied offences against the petitioner. Considering the nature of allegations revealed from the FIR, this Court is not inclined to consider the plea of pre-arrest bail of the petitioner, however, allows the liberty for him to surrender before the learned court below seeking regular bail.



4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. It is further directed that in the event, the petitioner surrenders within fifteen days from today before learned NGN-cum-J.M.F.C., Tangi in connection with Tangi P.S. Case No.312 of 2025 corresponding to G.R. Case No.264 of 2025 and moves regular bail, it shall be duly considered and in case rejected during the first hour, he shall approach the learned Sessions Court during the second hour for orders on the same day considering the plea of parity as has been advanced at present and for the said purpose, the lower court record shall be made available.
