1. Shri Santosh Kumar Nanda, learned Advocate for the petitioner submitted that after disposal of revision petition being R.P. Case No.20 of 2024 vide order dated 14.08.2025 by the Additional Commissioner (C & S), Sambalpur-II (Annexure-1), the petitioner could lay his hands on certain documents showing source of title being passed on to him through his mother who was claiming the title by way of registered sale deed of the year 1965.
2. Since certain document which has come to be possessed by the petitioner after disposal of the revision petition, he was deprived of placing the same before the revisional authority to establish his case. He submitted that had the document been produced, the conclusion of the revisional authority would have been otherwise.
3. Issue notice.



4. Mr. Saswsat Das, learned Additional Government Advocate appears and waives issue of notice on behalf of the opposite party nos.1 and 2 as a copy of the writ petition has already been served on him.
5. Issue notice to the opposite party nos.3 to 7 by Speed Post with A.D., requisites for which shall be filed within three working days. In the event of furnishing such requisites within the period stipulated, Office shall send the notice to the said opposite parties by fixing a short returnable date.
6. List this matter in the week commencing on 4th May, 2026.
