1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and State.
2. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS by the petitioners seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Jagatsinghpur P.S. Case No.324 of 2018 corresponding to G.R. Case No.1145 of 2018 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Jagatsinghpur on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. Gone through the chargesheet as at Annexure-2. A copy of the bail order in ABLAPL No.635 of 2019 is at Flag-A and the same is also perused. In fact, the petitioners had been allowed to go on bail in the event of arrest by order dated 29th March, 2019 in the above ABLAPL. In the meantime, the chargesheet is filed with the closure of investigation. Recorded the objection of the State, according to whom, the victim has received injury for the alleged incident. In reply to the above, learned counsel for the



petitioners would submit that the injury has been simple. In view of the above facts and submissions of learned counsel for the respective parties and as in the meantime, chargesheet as per Annexure-2 is filed, in view of the order in the ABLAPL, this Court is inclined to direct petitioners to appear before the learned court below and to go on bail with suitable conditions in the changed circumstances narrated above.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. It is further directed that in the event, the petitioners surrender before the learned S.D.J.M., Jagatsinghpur in connection with Jagatsinghpur P.S. Case No.324 of 2018 corresponding to G.R. Case No.1145 of 2018 within a fortnight from today, they shall be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs.30,000/-(rupees thirty thousand) each with one solvent surety for the like amount each with such other conditions imposed as deemed just and proper.
