1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. The appellant-petitioner has filed I.A. No. 212 of 2026 under Rule-22(2) of the Orissa Motor Vehicles (Accident Claims Tribunal) Rules, 1960 (in short, "the Rules") for exemption from paying of Court fee for time being.
