1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS by the petitioners seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Chandanpur P.S. Case No.287 of 2025 corresponding to G.R. Case No.1022 of 2025 pending in the court of learned Nyayadhikari, Gram Nayalaya, Puri on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the FIRs as at Annexures-1 & 2. The alleged incident has been described in the F.I.R. i.e. Annexure-1. The allegation therein is to the effect that the petitioners assaulted the informant's son by means of a sword but today, Mr. Panda, learned ASC for the State produced a copy of the medical examination report of the injured, namely, Bhimasen Rout and it reveals that he had no external injury but a blunt trauma on the chest stated to be simple in nature with an opinion therein that it might have been caused by hard and blunt object. As such, there is no any injury apparently by a sharp-edged weapon like sword which was allegedly used by the accused persons during the incident so revealed from the F.I.R. The



reason behind alleged incident is revealed from the F.I.Rs. In fact, a counter F.I.R. is lodged from the side of the petitioners i.e. Annexure-2. Of course, it is brought to the notice of the Court that some of the petitioners are having antecedent but it is not denied by the State that the F.I.Rs. have been lodged out of a family dispute between the parties. Considering the above facts and submission of learned counsel for the respective parties, this Court is of the view that the petitioners who are though found to be involved in the alleged incident should instead be directed to surrender before the learned court below for being released with suitable conditions imposed and accordingly, it is ordered.

4. In the result, the ABLAPL petition stands disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to surrender before learned Nyayadhikari, Gram Nayalaya, Puri within a fortnight from today for being released on bail in connection with Chandanpur P.S. Case No.287 of 2025 corresponding to C.T. Case No.82 of 2026 on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (rupees twenty five thousand) each with one solvent surety for the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below, which shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case besides the following such as; they shall not pick up any quarrel with the informant and others while on bail and to co-operate the I.O. in the investigation, till closure the same.

5. Issue urgent certified copy of this order as per rules.
