2. The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer:-

“Therefore it is prayed that the writ petition may be admitted, records maybe called for and after hearing the parties, the writ petition maybe allowed by directing the OPP Parties to look into the petitioner’s grievance by quashing the orders under ANNEXURE-5,6, and 7 by directing the Opp.



Parties to mitigate the petitioner's grievance forthwith through their remedial intervention.

And / or pass any other order or direction which deems fit and proper for the interest of justice

And for which act of kindness, the petitioners as in duty bound shall ever prayed".

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting his grievance, Petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.2 vide Annexure-4 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time by Opposite Party No.1 as the same has been forwarded to Opposite Party No.1s vide letter dtd.08.01.2026, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection. (Copy of letter dtd.08.01.2026 so produced in Court be kept in record.

As agreed by learned counsel for the parties and after going through the records, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the Writ Petition directing Opposite Party No.1 to consider the representation filed by the Petitioner under Annexure-4, so forwarded to him vide letter dtd.07.01.2026, within a period of two (2) weeks in accordance with law. Petitioner is directed to provide a copy of this order along with the representation under Annexure-4 and forwarding letter dtd.08.01.2026 before Opposite Party No.1 for compliance.

Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
