1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. The petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayer:-

“Under the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is therefore, humbly prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit the writ petition and shall be pleased to issue notice to the Opposite Parties seeking show cause as to why writ application shall not be allowed, if the Opposite Parties fail to file show cause or files insufficient cause then this Hon’ble Court shall be pleased to direct the Opposite Party No.3 to take decision in the Mutation Case Nos.9799/2025 and 9800/2025 within a specified period fix up by this Hon’ble Court and according to issue ROR in favour of the petitioners.

And/or pass any other order/orders as deems fit and proper in the interest of justice;
