3. Basing on the instruction, Ms. R.R. Jena, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Mr. L.K. Maharana, learned counsel for the TPCODL contended that power supply has already been provided to the Petitioner's premises with reconnection today itself.

Since it is the case of the Petitioner that without any prior notice and in absence of any demand, power supply was disconnected on 24.09.2025 and it was restored only today, this Court directs learned counsel appearing for TPCODL to file an affidavit justifying the reason for disconnecting power supply to the Petitioner's premises on 24.09.2025 and also whether prior to such disconnection any notice was issued to the Petitioner.
5. Such an affidavit be filed before the next date.
