03. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
2. By means of this application, the Petitioner seeks the indulgence of this Court for a direction to the Opposite Party No.4 to take appropriate action on the basis of his complaint dated 16.01.2026.
3. Mr. Behura, learned Addl. Govt. Advocate submitted that upon instruction, it could be ascertained that no such complaint has been received by the concerned police station and the complainant has also been requested to submit a written complaint with regard to the grievance. However, the complainant did not turn up as yet.



4. Having regard to the aforesaid instruction, the Petitioner, who is the son of the beneficiary under the Prime Minister's Housing Scheme (PMAY), is required to submit a written complaint before the concerned police station within a period of fifteen (15) days during office hours between 10.00 A.M. to 1.00 P.M. In the event any such complaint is filed, the IIC, Chandpur P.S., shall examine the same and in the event the complaint reveals a cognizable offence, to proceed in accordance with law.

5. The CRLMP stands disposed of accordingly.
