1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed seeking pre-arrest bail of the petitioner in connection with G.R Case No.1806 of 2025 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C (R), Cog Court, Berhampur arising out of Golanthara P.S. Case No.514 of 2025 on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. The alleged incident is narrated by the informant. The submission is that the petitioner and the informant were having friendship with a girl and in that connection, the differences arose leading to the alleged incident. The claim is that the petitioner though alleged of having assaulted the informant, for the latter, received no grievous injury. It is informed to the Court that the informant has lodged two more FIRs against the petitioner and one by the



girl herself. From the report at Annexure-1, it is made to understand that the petitioner gave fist blow to the informant causing injury and committed such other mischief in course of the incident. Recording the submission that the victim has not received any serious injury and objection of the State and the fact that the other antecedents are at the behest of the informant and the girl not named in the FIR, this Court though not inclined to consider pre-arrest bail, however, is of the view that the petitioner should instead be directed to surrender before the learned court below for being released on bail with suitable conditions imposed.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. In the event, the petitioner surrender before the court of learned J.M.F.C (R), Cog Court, Berhampur, it is directed that he shall be released on bail in connection with G.R Case No.1806 of 2025 corresponding to Golanthara P.S. Case No.514 of 2025 on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.30,000/-(rupees thirty thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount with such other conditions imposed as deemed just and proper and in the facts and circumstances of the case besides the following, such as, he shall not cause any harm to the informant and also the girl, who said to have lodged a report against him in any manner, whatsoever, while



on bail and to cooperate the I.O. in the investigation, till the same is over.

6. Issue urgent certified copy of this order as per rules.
